

DTE In Comparison to WebView

- WebView is not a time entry solution. WebView is a limited version of the accounting system that provides firm-wide access to financial and practice management data. These include Billing, Case, Collections, Conflicts, Records Manager, Time Entry and Apex Marketing Manager that provide similar functionality of the Elite Enterprise platform.
 - DTE is a focused and full-featured time entry solution that enables users to capture more billable time, faster and with greater flexibility across a variety of platforms. DTE helps extend Elite's capabilities by providing not only more billable time, but better validated data, such as spelling, e-billing and other customer requirements.
- Specifically how it relates to time entry, WebView is dependant and rooted on the core accounting system version. What this means to a firm is that any updates that are available for time entry often require the entire core Elite Enterprise accounting platform to be forced in to upgrading at the same time. Firms that choose to "not" upgrade in a timely fashion simply are stuck and miss out on new features.
 - DTE is available on the desktop, web, and BlackBerry each platform independent from Elite. DTE powerful backend is not married to "any" billing system platform. This offers firms the freedom to choose any billing system at any time, regardless if it's the newer 3E technology from Elite or a full-scale change to a competitor such as Aderant's CMS. DTE keeps users productive by offering steadfast consistency with a powerful user interfaces that can be implemented without compromising any back-end billing system.
- The Elite WebView accounting system has many accounting modules that make up the system. One of these modules is dedicated to time entry. Applications with greater complexity inherently run and operate much slower than streamlined applications with a deep focus.
 - DTE is independent of the billing system, distributing the administrative and end user workload across both systems. Limiting Elite WebView access to only accounting users increases performance and allows them to perform accounting tasks much faster. As a bonus, it also creates a level of fault tolerance, should the billing system become unavailable.
If Billing system is unavailable, time entry users will not be affected. Likewise, if too much traffic is being generated by the end user workload, accounting is not affected.
